PhotoSweeper is a fast, precise & super efficient tool designed to eliminate similar or duplicate photos even in huge photo collections. It works with Photos, iPhoto, Aperture, Capture One and Lightroom Classic media libraries as well as photos from your hard drives and external storages.

As a Mac user like myself, I am sure that you will have hundreds of unwanted duplicate photos. These duplicate photos take up a lot of unwanted storage usage and just cause overall frustration and headaches.

Are you looking for a solution to sweep your photos clean?

If so, check out PhotoSweeper for Mac.

PhotoSweeper finds Photos by-

Name, capture date, rating, colour label, favourite, flagged, rejected, referenced, on cloud, marked, locked, missing, keywords, file type, file size, file created date, file modified date, folder name, album name, project name, library name, image width, image

height, image orientation, image DPI, colour profile name, exposure time, F number, focal length, ISO speed rating, flash fired, camera maker, camera model, camera lens model, editing software.

You are able to fine tune and control the parameters of what PhotoSweeper actually considers a duplicate.

There is a general slider that allows you to vary between partial or exact matching.

As you can see, PhotoSweeper contains the most complete setting to fast find photos. Most of its competitors just allow users to find photos according to some common-used parameters, such as Name, File Size, Created Date, File Type.

Is PhotoSweeper a good app?

My experience is that PhotoSweeper works extremely well in finding and removing duplicate photos, but it is not simple to use, especially when you want to utilise some of its advanced features for accurate scanning and removal.

You may need to run PhotoSweeper several times to ensure all duplicates are caught.

If you decide to give PhotoSweeper a try, my suggestion would be to first download and read the manual carefully before you start. It explains all the features of the app in a clear and concise manner.

Bottom Line:

If you've got a Mac and lots of photos to sort through, I would recommend trying PhotoSweeper. It is one of the best duplicate photo detection apps that I have used and is probably the best one that you will find in this price range.

I understand that with the recent release of the new operating system 'Ventura', that it includes an option for 'Duplicate photo finder', but I am unable offer any comment as to its capabilities, as I do not have 'Ventura' on my computer. I am waiting to purchase a new 27 inch iMac, but it appears as if Apple may not release a new 27 inch model.

If, like me, you are in need of reviewing and cleaning up your photo library, then I would recommend that you try out the free trial available from PhotoSweeper. Once you understand how it works, I am sure that you will be more than pleased with your purchase.
